

NOTICE OF ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLANS
THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF JENKINTOWN

Effective October 30, 1987, the Federal Government passed legislation (AHRA Regulation 40 CFR 763) that requires public school districts to inspect their schools for the presence of asbestos containing materials. The law requires that schools identify the condition, type, location and accessibility of asbestos containing materials.

The law further directs school districts to present a comprehensive Asbestos Management Plan to the State Department of Education for examination and approval. The School District of Jenkintown, through the services of a professional environmental consulting firm, has complied with the initial requirements and has also completed all required three year re-inspections and updated the management plan as necessary.

The school district has implemented all phases of our Asbestos Management Plan, including staff awareness training, postings and notifications, continued monitoring, operational and maintenance procedures, and has successfully completed every removal project undertaken. The Asbestos Management Plan is on file in the school district office.
