Our District Goals for 2024-25

Continue to Strengthen Academic Supports for Students

- Continue to analyze student performance data to identify strengths and areas where we can improve our supports.
- Collaborate as a teaching staff to ensure student progress is regularly updated and monitored, and feedback for students is as timely and meaningful as possible

Expand Co-Curricular Offerings

Strengthen Curricular Programs
